Career Mentoring for Educated International Women in Finnish

Join the new Auroras language groups to strengthen your Finnish language skills for working life

You can apply as a mentee in the Auroras mentoring group or as a participant in the Spouse Program-Auroras language group.

You will learn about Finnish working life, get support for job hunting, create networks and strengthen your Finnish language skills. You can apply to join Auroras groups if you are an educated woman who has moved to Finland, and you wish to receive support to your career in Finland. Auroras mentors are educated women who are familiar with Finnish working life.

Auroras mentoring groups

- Finnish language level: B1
- One group consists of 6-8 mentees and 2-3 mentors.
- We organize local groups in different parts of Finland and remote groups in Zoom.
- The group discusses topics related to working life in Finnish. Group's mentees and mentors may be from different industries, so the discussions are related to general working life themes.
- The group meets once a week for 2 hours, a total 12 times.
- Auroras network organizes events during the mentoring program, in which you can network and develop your skills.

Auroras language groups

- Finnish language level: A2
- One group consists of 6-12 participants and 2-3 instructors.
- The group will meet in Maria 01, Lapinlahdenkatu 16, 00180 Helsinki, strarting in Febreruary
- The group meets once a week for 2 hours, a total of 8 times (until April 2025).
- After participating in the language group, you can apply to join the mentoring groups in the following term.
